Residents living within Indianola city limits are eligible to purchase trees for \$25 each (with the remaining cost funded through the Indianola Community Tree Committee). Tree purchase is initially limited to two trees per household to ensure all customers have an opportunity to purchase trees. **Advance purchase is required.** The tree nursery will contact you to make planting arrangements (If you choose to plant the tree yourself, you must call Iowa One Call, 1-800-292-8989, to have buried utilities flagged at least 48 hrs before you dig). The tree may be staked, tied, and mulched for an additional \$12 per tree. *Trees are available on a first come-first serve basis.*

For spring planting, trees may be ordered and paid for from Mar 15 – April 9, 2010.
For fall planting, trees may be ordered and paid for from Aug 9 – Sept 3, 2010.

Shumard Oak

60-80' tall x 40-60' wide. Pyramidal to rounded shape. Deeply cut lustrous dark green leaves may develop a good russet-red to red fall color. Relatively easy to transplant and drought tolerant.

Greenspire Linden

40-50' tall x 30-35' wide. Oval shape. This 1998 Iowa Tree of the Year has a straight trunk, leathery green leaves, and yellow fall color. Adaptable and often planted as a street tree.

Louisa Crabapple

15' tall x 15' wide. Attractive weeping form. Red buds open to pink flowers in spring. Glossy, dark green leaves are resistant to disease and Japanese beetles. Persistent 3/8" golden yellow fruit with a slight blush in fall.

Leonard Messel Magnolia

15-20' Tall x 20-25' wide. Upright to rounded shape with age. Fragrant flowers are 4-6" across with 12-15 petals flushed with fuchsia-pink to purple on the outside, white on the inside. Truly a beautiful spring flowering tree.
